‘Hosanna to the Son of David!

‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!

‘Hosanna in the highest!’”

Hymn: Prepare the royal highway

Priest: "O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker."

Priest: "Who shall go up to the mountain of Jehovah?"

Congregation: "And who shall stand in the place of His holiness?"

Priest: "He who is innocent of hands,"

Congregation: "And pure of heart,"

Priest: "Who has not lifted up His soul to vanity,"

Congregation: "And has not promised with deceit."

Priest: "He shall bear the blessing from Jehovah,"

Congregation: "And justice from the God of His salvation."

The Priest may offer a prayer.

All: "Our Father, who art in the heavens, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so upon the earth. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen."

Priest: "O Lord, forgive us our trespasses,"

Congregation: "As we forgive those who trespass against us."

Hymn: Open your eyes, see the glory of the King

All say the following recitation.

“And as He went, they spread their garments in the way. And when He was already near to the descent of the Mount of Olives, all the multitude of the disciples rejoicing began to praise God with a great voice for all the works of power that they had seen, saying, Blessed be the King who comes in the name of the Lord!
