**Board of Trustees Meeting:** The board met on Tuesday, April 14, to discuss in further detail a loan request from Old School Village (OSV). I am pleased to announce that the board voted unanimously to loan OSV \$300,000 at a 5% interest rate for a term of seven years. The board feels confident that the terms of the loan are beneficial to the church, that in the case of a forfeiture the value of the building will far outweigh the value of the loan, that—though not the church's responsibility—the use is an integral part of our church society, and that this is a one-time exception to not entertaining loan requests.
