**Arcana Class:** Readings are AC 9363-9401. These teachings begin with a section from the Doctrine of Charity and Faith on the subject of Faith by Persuasion, and are followed by the explanation of the internal sense of Exodus 24:1-8, which describes the preparation for Moses to go up Mount Sinai and receive the ten commandments on the tables of stone from Jehovah. This chapter treats of the Word of the Lord and how it is Divine in both the literal sense and in its internal sense, and the use of both senses in the life of man.
