**1) 7:30 P.M. on Wednesday the 20<sup>th</sup>.** A continuation of our September 22 class – the Word and its spiritual or internal sense from *Arcana Coelestia* in the little work *The White Horse*. Subjects include the necessity and excellence of the Word; that the Word is not understood without enlightenment, and without doctrine from the Word; that there is a spiritual or internal sense in the Word, which is primarily for angels but also for men; that there are countless things hidden there, because the Word has been written by correspondences.

**2) 7:30 P.M. Arcana class on Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup>.** Reading: AC 9585-9632. We will begin with the section on the Doctrine of Charity and Faith on Freedom, and then focus on the internal sense of the curtains of the Tabernacle which, in general, correspond to the truths of the spiritual heaven, while the planks (which we will study in November) correspond to the supporting good within the curtains.
