(Repeat) Can You Help with Perhaps Getting Access to High-Speed Internet in Kempton? As many of us know, Kempton appears as a black hole on the map that shows where high-speed internet **can be accessed** in Berks County. (To be clear: DSL is NOT high speed; only Blue Ridge Cable can provide high speed.) The county has hired a firm to do some research so it can apply for funds for this from the Infrastructure Bill and some other programs. They need data, however, on who **has access** (whether they chose to avail themselves of it or not) **and who does not**.
