What should I bring? If you can bring your own clippers, that would be great. (I'll have a few spares if you need to borrow some.)

Do I need to know how to make a wreath? No, I'll be available to show you how to make your wreath if you are new to it or need a review. The process is pretty formulaic. You are also welcome to come and cut greens for others if that is more your speed.
