Cascadia New Church is looking to hire a part-time Administrator to help run the day-to-day needs of our church, and support our virtual and hybrid worship services. Cascadia is a newly formed regional congregation primarily serving Southern British Columbia, Washington, and Oregon. This position can be done 100% remotely and will report to the Cascadia New Church board. The hours are flexible, with the exception of worship service times.

The Administrator will help develop a regular newsletter, send out official announcements, communicate with congregational members, coordinate with visiting ministers, manage logistics such as renting venues, and perform other relevant duties, as needed.

The ideal candidate will have exceptional communication skills, be self-driven, and be proficient in basic office suites and other programs, such as Zoom, needed to support Cascadia. It is expected that the individual has a familiarity with and love for the teachings of the New Church. Cascadia operates in the Pacific time zone, and it is preferred, but not required, for a candidate to live in or adjacent to that time zone.

This position will be for 20-hours a week, and pays \$23-\$30/hour, depending on skill/experience.
