Kempton New Church School is seeking applicants for a part-time high school science teaching position for the 2025-26 academic school year. **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Responsibilities include teaching 11th and 12th grade chemistry and human anatomy. As Kempton New Church school is organized into two-grade classrooms, these sciences are taught in alternating years. For the 2025-26 school year, anatomy is the 11th and 12th grade science being offered. The successful applicant will engage students in learning about the sciences from the light of the Sacred Scripture and Heavenly Doctrines, while staying up to date on current scientific research and best practices for teaching the courses listed above. They will create a positive and orderly learning environment within the classroom. The individual will be expected to work collaboratively with parents.

- Bachelor's degree, preferably in one of the hard sciences
- Ability to work collaboratively with other teachers
- Ability to maintain confidentiality
