Renting at Old School Village:

A two-bedroom apartment will soon be available at OSV.

- 1. Rentals are available to those who are (or become) members of the Kempton New Church.
- 2. Long-term: If you are 60 years or older when entering an apartment, by paying a one-time entrance fee you are guaranteed that apartment for as long as you want and are able to live there. To be eligible for this 60-and-above arrangement, you first need to be on OSV's priority (waiting) list, which costs \$500. This fee is refundable (if you want to get off the list); does not obligate you if an apartment becomes available and is offered to you, but you reject it; and goes toward the entrance fee if you accept the apartment.

- 3. Month-to-Month: Adults of any age may rent an apartment without first being on the priority list or paying the entrance fee, though this is a month-to-month arrangement only. Renters in this category understand they may be asked to vacate if someone 60- and-above who is on the priority list becomes ready to move in.
- 4. If thinking about ever living at OSV, call Tom Kerr to get on the priority list (484-436-1014). He can also always answer questions of any relevant nature.
