## The Annunciation: JEHOVAH CAME INTO THE WORLD

And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent out from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the name of the virgin was Mary. And the angel coming into her said, Hail, thou who art graced! The Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women.

But when she saw him she was disturbed at his word, and reasoned within herself what manner of a greeting this should be. And the angel said to her, Fear not, Mary; for thou hast found grace with God. And behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and shalt bring forth a Son, and shalt call His name Jesus. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest, and the Lord God shall give to Him the throne of His father David. And He shall reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there shall be no end. But Mary said to the angel, How shall this be, since I know not a man? And the angel answering said to her, The Holy Spirit shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee; therefore also that which shall be born of thee Holy shall be called the Son of God.

And behold thy kinswoman Elizabeth, she also has conceived a son in her old age; and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren. For with God not any saying shall be impossible. And Mary said, Behold, the maidservant of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy saying. And the angel departed from her. Luke 1:26-36

By Gabriel is meant the ministry [in heaven] of those who teach from the Word, that Jehovah came into the world, and that the Human He there assumed is the Son of God, and Divine; for which reason, the angel who announced the same to Mary is called "Gabriel." AR 548

## PASTOR'S NOTES

Gabriel's annunciation to Mary is meant as much for us today as it was for her over 2,000 years ago. Gabriel, who represents an entire ministry of angels who love to announce that the Lord came into the world, didn't stop teaching this once it was recorded in *Luke*. These angels in the Gabriel society are teaching us right now—through these beautiful words in the Sacred Scripture—that Jesus Christ is the Lord. And we can be part of this same ministry of angels. Perhaps this Christmas season we can look for ways to share the message that it was the Lord God Himself who came into the world, just like Gabriel announced it to Mary.

**The Board of Trustees** met on November 9. The board received a report on maintenance items for the facility, a report on the effects of inflation on the upcoming budget, and a review of how the pastor and assistant principal are approaching employment for the church and school to protect against falling into employment practices that undermine the New Church and especially conjugal love.

**Adult Service:** We will have an adult service on the morning of Sunday, December 19, because tableaux services are being offered in the afternoon on that day and these will be well suited for children. Parents are welcome, however, to bring their children to the adult service if they would like to.

**Holy Supper** will be offered on Friday, December 17, and on the first Sunday morning of the new year, January 2. "It has pleased the Lord to reveal the spiritual sense of the Word, to enable this church to enter into the real use and benefit of these sacraments, baptism and holy supper..." (TCR 700)

**Winter Study – The Parables:** For the first six weeks of every new year, those who wish to join in our study of a certain topic gather themselves into groups that meet once a week, generally in homes. This January and February our topic will be the parables given by the Lord in the New Testament. We hope these discussions will be inspiring and useful; gathering like this is a great way to make friends while learning together about the Lord and the ways He leads us.

**Reading booklets** will be provided ahead of time. They can be picked up after church each week (or at the church office) and will also be posted on our website (kemptonnewchurch.org).

**If you would like to host a group and have seats to offer, or if you want to join a class,** please let me or Carla Kerr know so we can help people get connected if needed. Groups are free to invite a minister to lead their discussion if they like. They can also meet in the school library or commons if a home isn't available, and arrange for Zoom attendance, wherever, if desired. (Due to COVID, meeting protocols should be made clear to everyone in the groups.) You might like to think about arranging to be part of a group before the holidays get busy, since the study will begin as soon in 2022 as each group is ready to start.
