NEITHER ADDING NOR TAKING AWAY

Deuteronomy 4:1-2

1 And now hearken, O Israel, to the statutes and to the judgments, which I teach you to do, so that you may live, and go in and possess the land which Jehovah God of your fathers gives you.

2 You shall not add to the word which I command you, and you shall not diminish from it, that you may keep the commandments of Jehovah your God which I command you.

Revelation 22:18-19

18 For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book, if anyone shall add to these things, God shall add on him the plagues that are written in this book.

19 And if anyone shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the book of life, and out of the holy city, and out of the things written in this book.

Doctrine of the Sacred Scripture 13.4

Be it known that in the spiritual sense all things hang together in a continuous connection, which is fitted together in such a manner by the force and meaning of all the words in the literal or natural sense, that if even a little word were taken out of it, the connection would be broken and the coherence would perish. In order to prevent this, it is added at the end of this prophetical book, That not a word shall be taken away (Rev. 22:19).

PASTOR'S NOTES

The Lord knows exactly what needs to be revealed and when. Keeping this in mind can help us understand how what the Lord said in *Deuteronomy* and *Revelation* about not adding or taking away is true.

Much more was written from Him both after *Deuteronomy* in the Old and New Testaments and after *Revelation* in the Heavenly Doctrine. But the Lord was not so much adding as He was revealing

more detail about what was already there at just the right time. Of course, only the Lord can do this.

In His Second Coming He teaches that "After the end of the Israelitish Church interior Divine truths were revealed by the Lord for the Christian Church, and now still more interior truths for the church that is to come. These interior truths are such as are in the internal or spiritual sense of the Word" (AE 948.2).

So when we think about the Lord explaining that the Word should not be added to or taken away from, we can now see that each revelation is the Lord speaking to us in more and more interior truths.

SUMMER "SUNDAY SCHOOL" SERVICES:

Parents, please take careful note about these services, which happen three times during the summer. During the summer the children's talk is not followed by a Sunday School class. Instead, parents are expected to supervise their children in the barn or outside during the sermon (making sure people outside are not within the view of worshippers inside).

It is important that all children actually be supervised in order to protect them from hurting others or having to endure the bad behavior of others. Thank you to parents, individually and collectively, for pulling together to make sure our kids are protected.

In the case of rain, certain indoor spaces may be used in addition to the barn, but it's imperative that an adult be in any room in which there are children, whatever their age. Close supervision matters in these spaces that are developed, used, and cared for

by those who work in the school, to whom we need to show respect. All places should of course be left as clean and tidy as you will undoubtedly find them. Available in bad weather (only): the 7th-8th classrooms, and the Commons.

As on every Sunday, please supervise your children when church is over, whether in the Society Room or outside.

WOODS / OUTDOOR SERVICES: On the last Sunday of each summer month (August 25, and September 29), there will be an indoor 9:00 a.m. Family Service and a 10:00 a.m. Family Service in the woods. If it rains, the 10:00 a.m. Woods Service will be held indoors, and the 9:00 a.m. indoor service will happen as well.

How to get to the woods: Park at the church, cross the street, and walk down the lane, following the signs. There is also parking in a field at the end of the lane, on the right, for those who prefer not to walk. Please stay on church property (toward the left as you travel the lane), and avoid driving onto our neighbor's property toward the right.

SUMMER DOCTRINAL CLASS: The last class on the book "Disease, Disaster and Divine Providence" by Rev. Arne Bau-Madsen will be offered at the Old School Village Lounge on Monday, August 26th at 7:30 p.m.

The Board of Trustees met on Tuesday, July 16. We reviewed the budget for the past fiscal year. Last year's budget ended up with a surplus which we decided to put toward the West End Renovation project and into unrestricted endowment. We also decided to go forward with a proposal for taking on

payroll and benefits. And lastly the board voted to sponsor Kempton's 150th anniversary celebration.

Pastor's Council met on Tuesday, July 23. We discussed the various kinds of church services offered and whether there are any ways we can better serve families with young children. We also discussed whether a building use policy would be helpful and how the 19th of June Service went. Finally, we spent some more time on a very rough draft of a possible process for addressing the sanctuary. This last topic continued from the last two meetings and will continue to be the subject of several future Pastor's Council meetings so please feel free to let us know your thoughts about a good process. I have heard from some of you already and it really helps!

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The election of trustees and school council members will take place at the society meeting on October 10, 2024.

The trustees whose terms expire this year are Thos Powell, Doug Robertson and John Cole. Terms are for three years. There are no term limits in the Bylaws, so they can be re-nominated indefinitely. Terms for the School Council are also for three years and like the terms for board members there are no term limits. The other members of the School Council are Vera Cole, Sheila Heiter (2025) and Matt Saltzer.

The members of the Nominating Committee are Cedric Lumsden, chair, Seth King and Wade Buick. Please speak to one of them if you have suggestions. A slate will be published in the September and October Newsletters.
